The Strategic Plan becomes a "living" document

- At the beginning of each calendar year Staff and Board Committees identify objectives relating to one or more of the Strategic Plan Goals for which they have some responsibility for.
 - These objectives include a detailed **Work Plan** that include specific activities, assignment of responsibility and a timeline for completion.
- The Work Plan is reviewed monthly by staff and updated to show the efforts made towards completion of individual Work Plans, and ultimately, the final status of the objective.
- Final status of individual Work Plans are reviewed at the end of the year and determined to be "complete", "in process" or, "removed with reason".



Working the Plan (continued)

- A full review of the prior year's plan is presented to the Board of Directors, individual staff and committee teams, at the beginning of the new year.
- Objectives for the new year are created, complete with specific Work Plans, and the process continues into the next year of the Strategic Plan.
- Every three years, the Board of Directors and key staff meet to review the full three-year Plan and to consider the coming three-year period such as known threats, opportunities, program needs, etc.
- A new three-year Plan is developed.
