

2024 Impact Statement

Patient Care

2,704 primary care visits were provided to **889 unique patients** at no charge to the patient. **1,959** instances of other services were provided.

- In addition to routine facility and direct patient care costs, we assume all costs for patients lab tests and imaging services.
- Behavioral health assessments, crisis interventions and community referrals.
- Medical outreach to unhoused persons through our Street Medicine program.
- General and disease-specific case management.
- Social determinants of health assessments for 236 new patients and reassessment of prior.
- Diabetes management and education for high-risk and non-compliant patients.
- Flu vaccinations were administered in partnership with Riverside University Health Services.

The total number of medical visits provided since opening in 2010 is 46,084 for 5,052 unique patients.

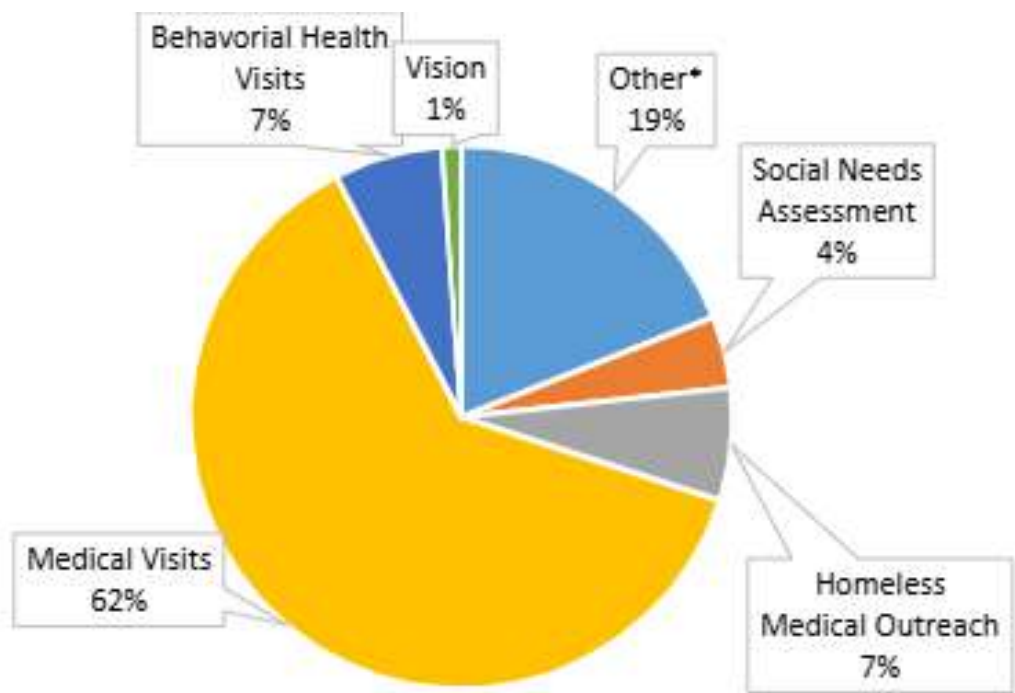


Volunteers

237 volunteers donated **8,797 hours** of their time, expertise, and talent to support our mission. Their services contributed an in-kind donation of **\$580,898** considering average wage and salary information for the region (US Department of Labor).

43 physicians, nurse practitioners and physician assistants were directly involved in patient care. **111 Family or Internal Medicine residents** from Eisenhower Health or Desert Regional Medical Center provided care under the direction of a supervising physician at our Indio or Palm Springs clinics. **30 RNs, LVNs and Medical Assistants** assisted with patient care and other clinical services. **53 general clinic volunteers** provided reception assistance and served as Spanish translators, medical scribes and data entry clerks.
